Wendy Carrillo immigrated to the United States as a young child during the civil war in El Salvador, and was elected to the State Assembly in 2017 from East LA. In 7 years in office she earned a 100% voting score with the California Federation of Labor for four years, and held a lifetime voting record of 97%. She was arrested during Local 11's 2023 civil disobedience action supporting our citywide contract negotiations.

Sara Hernandez is the President of the Trustees on the LA Community College District Board. She is a housing lawyer who also helps immigrants in asylum proceedings, DACA renewals, and unjust detentions. She is endorsed by the Teachers Unions, the Teamsters Union, the UNAC Nurses Union, and Farmworker Union leader Dolores Huerta.

Juan Camacho was born in México and came to California as a toddler. He was a student activist against Proposition 187. He serves as President of Equality California Institute, where he leads programs to protect LGBTQ+ civil rights. He is endorsed by the Stonewall Democratic Club and State Treasurer Fiona Ma.

Jose Ugarte immigrated with his family from Mexico. He became a leader in Councilmember Curren Price's office, where he helped pass the Olympic Minimum Wage for hospitality workers. He is endorsed by the LA County Democratic Party, the United Food and Commercial Workers Union, the Teamsters Union, CHIRLA Action Fund, and La Opinión.

Estuardo Mazariegos immigrated to Los Angeles as a child fleeing political violence in Guatemala. He is the co-director of the Alliance of Californians for Community Empowerment (ACCE), a close ally of Local 11, where he has advocated for tenants and affordable housing. He refuses to take money from corporate PACs or real estate developers.
