On behalf of 30,000 workers in the hospitality and food service industry in Southern California and Southern Arizona, we write to you with one simple demand: Stop Flushing Canada's Boreal Forest! Working people around the world are bearing the brunt of the dramatic effects of climate change and environmental degradation. Our members, including thousands of hotel housekeepers, clean bathrooms in thousands of hotel rooms across the Southwest and take special interest in making sure these bathrooms are sustainable. Virgin forests are the lungs of the world, and it is appalling that no recycled material is used to make Charmin.

Not only does the Canadian boreal forest store vast amounts of carbon, it's also home to hundreds of Indigenous communities and to the iconic boreal caribou. P&G has the power to flip the script. Please commit to not fuel deforestation or primary forest degradation in your entire supply chain. P&G must involve Indigenous communities in sourcing decisions, act to protect caribou habitat, and take other important steps toward sustainability.

Please move quickly to ensure that your products don't come at the cost of this globally important ecosystem.
